



Cra-Z-Art Glue Make your own slime!

What you will need:

- 4oz Clear or White Cra-Z-Art Glue
- Dish Soap
- Contact Lens Solution
- Mixing Bowl
- Measuring Spoon (1 teaspoon, ½ teaspoon)

Directions:

1) Pour 4oz of Cra-Z-Art Glue into your Mixing Bowl.

2) Mix in Dish soap, 1 teaspoon at a time and stir well. Continue to add small increments of Dish Soap until the mixture in the bowl becomes harder to stir, has a cloud-like texture, and pulls from the edges of the bowl while you stir.

3) Once you have seen these changes in your bowl, you will add Contact Lens Solution. Similarly to what you did in Step 1, add ½ a teaspoon at a time and stir. After adding a few ½ teaspoons, you should begin to see slime form. If the mixture is not thickening and releasing from the edges of the bowl add more Dish Soap and then come back to this step.

4) Now that all of the contents have been added, test the consistency of your slime by sticking your fingers in it.

- If it is very sticky and overall not very dense, add more Dish Soap.
- If it is slightly sticky, add more Contact Lens Solution.

5) Once you achieve the desired consistency experiment with adding glitter, beads, and other fun additives!

* Contact Lens Solution must contain Boric Acid or Sodium Borate

* Dish Soap should be of quality brand (Results and measurements differ among soap brands)

Always wash hands thoroughly after making and handling slime. Slime should be made under adult supervision.
